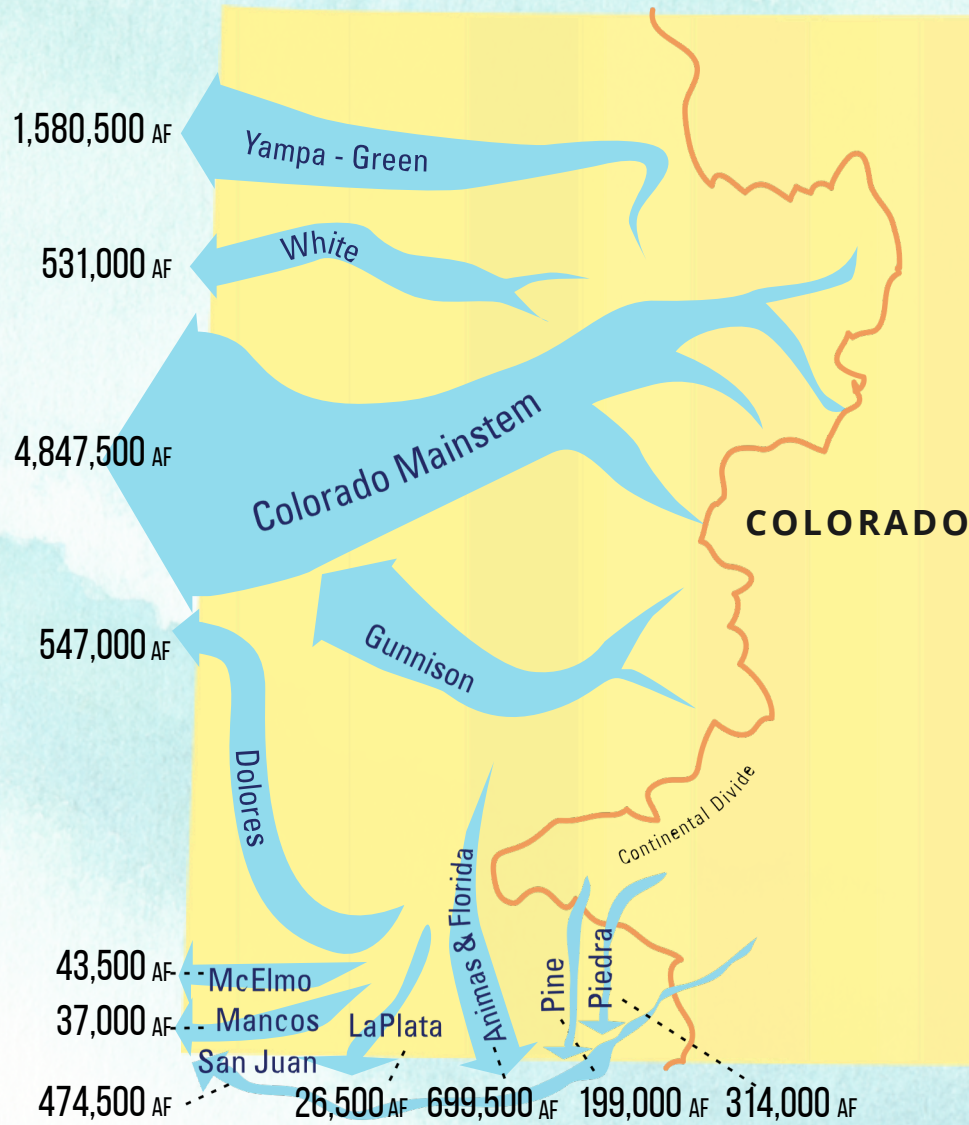


WHAT COLORADO CONTRIBUTES

EFFORTS THAT SUPPORT A HEALTHY COLORADO RIVER



WATER PLAN GRANTS PROGRAM

\$87M IN AWARDS for multibenefit water projects across the State that conserve water and promote efficiency, including a **\$1.5M GRANT** for water-wise landscaping.



WATER LOSS PREVENTION

MILLIONS INVESTED in the CO Water Loss Initiative. Colorado trained over 90 water utilities across the state; 50 utilities identified over **20,000 ACRE-FEET** in preventable losses in Phase 1.



WATERSHED RESTORATION

Awarded more than **\$22 MILLION** to restore and protect the headwater watersheds of the Colorado River, build wildfire and flood resilience, stabilize streams, and reconnect land and water.



AVERAGE ANNUAL SHORTAGES

Colorado regularly takes significant hydrologic shortages averaging **600,000 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR** through strict priority administration. The Upper Division States shortages average **1.3M ACRE-FEET PER YEAR**.
